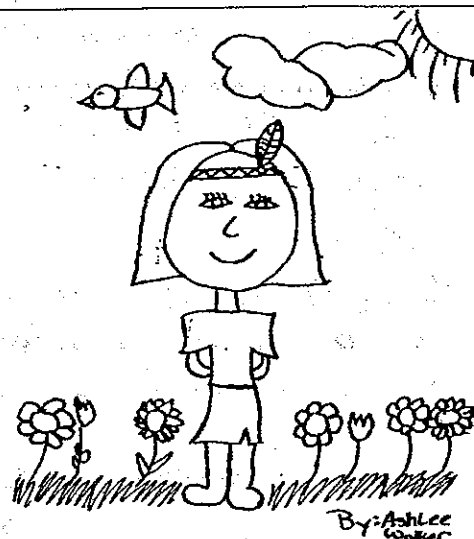


Meet the Widow Ladner, Mr. Quarles, Captain Pitcher, and MORE on the...
